- 1896:** “Geheimnis” for chorus and string orchestra + (EMI cd)
“Waldgesprach” for soprano, two horns, harp and strings

“Frühlingsglaube” for chorus and strings + (EMI cd)
- 1897:** Symphony No.2 in B flat major: 41 minutes + (Decca, Chandos, EMI and Naxos cds)

- 1900:** Psalm 83 for chorus and orchestra

- 1901:** “Ein Tanzpoem” for orchestra: 35 minutes + (EMI cd)
- 1902-03:** Symphonic Poem “Die Seejungfrau” for orchestra: 44 minutes

- 1910:** Psalm 23 for chorus and orchestra, op.14: 10 minutes + (Decca cd)
- 1913/21:** “Sechs Gesange” for medium voice and chamber orchestra, op.13
- 1913-15:** Suite “Cymbeline” for tenor and orchestra: 17 minutes + (EMI and Chandos cds)
- 1922:** Lyric Symphony for soprano, baritone and orchestra, op.18: 43 minutes

- 1929:** “Symphonische Gesange” for contralto or baritone and orchestra, op.20
