- 1903: Viola Concerto in G minor: 26 minutes + (*Hyperion cd*)**
- 1905: Suite "Four Studies from Victor Hugo" for orchestra
"Chanson Celtique" for Viola and Orchestra**
- 1915: "The Last Supper: a Lenten Meditation" for baritone, chorus and orchestra**
- 1918: "A Masque" for medium voice and orchestra
"When the Last Sea is Sailed" for low voice and orchestra**
- 1919: Choral Ballad "Tinker, Tailor" for soprano, bass, female chorus and orchestra**
- 1920: Variations from the Nursery Rhyme "Old King Cole" for chorus and string orchestra**
- 1922: Choral Ballad "The Luck of Eden Hall" for soprano, male chorus and orchestra
"The Dark Road" for Viola and Strings**
- 1927: Suite "Alice in Wonderland" for orchestra and chorus ad.lib.**
- 1931: "My Difficulties with May" for baritone, male chorus and orchestra**
