- 1923:** “The Nightingale”-lyrical poem for orchestra  
**1924:** Fugue in B minor for small orchestra  
**1925:** Sketch “Kinder Scout” for orchestra: 6 minutes \*
- 1929:** “The Last Memory”\_Rhapsody for Cello and Orchestra with soprano voice  
**1931:** Symphonic Ballad “The Trees so High” for baritone, chorus and orchestra:  
34 minutes + (Lyrita and Chandos cds)
- 1935:** “La Belle Dame sans Merci” for tenor, chorus and orchestra: 10 minutes  
+ (Chandos cd)
- 1936:** “My Beloved Spake” for choir and orchestra  
**1937:** “Marianna” for mezzo-soprano and small orchestra
- 1942:** Cantata “The Travellers” for soprano, chorus and orchestra: 8 minutes  
“One Morning in Spring-Sketch for orchestra”: 4 minutes + (Chandos cd)
- 1944:** Cantata “The Hills” for soprano, tenor, bass, chorus and orchestra:  
36 minutes + (EMI cd)
- 1955:** Cantata “Fen and Flood” for soprano, baritone, hours and orchestra:  
25 minutes + (Albion cd)
- 1958:** Cantata “Connemara” for soprano, tenor, baritone, chorus and orchestra  
**1962:** Lenten Meditations for tenor, bass, chorus and orchestra: 18 minutes
